May's item is baby lotion or shampoo. Kate's Cupboard volunteers will bring donations left in the Gathering Space to the Cupboard on Monday.

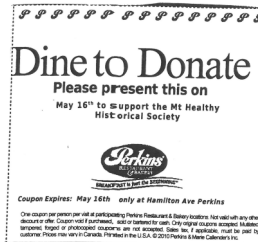

### Hymn Notes

The Hymn of the Month for May is "*Gracious Spirit, Heed our Pleading*", ELW 401. As we add verses to our HOM every week, we can be reminded of the inspiration from which it came. The writer of the words, Wilson Niwagila, was born in Tanzania and studied at Marangu Teachers College and the Lutheran Theological College, now Makumira University College in Arusha, Tanzania. After serving as a pastor for three years in Tanzania, he came to Wartburg Seminary in Dubuque, Iowa, where he received his MDiv and STM. From 1975-1979 he served as the religious education secretary of the ELC in Tanzania. He earned his PhD at University of Hamburg, has written several books and since 1999 he has been executive secretary for evangelism of the Bavarian Lutheran Mission in Tanzania. His book *Partnership and power* was published in 1996.

The tune, a Ganda folk melody, is given with a harmonization by **Egil Hovland**, a Norwegian organist and composer. Born in Oslo, he studied church music at the Oslo Conservatory and since 1949 has been organist and choirmaster at the Glemmen Church in Frederikstad.
